

Chinook Regional Hospital Foundation 50/50 Biweekly Lottery Official Rules & Regulations (AGLC Raffle License)

Licensee: Chinook Regional Hospital Foundation (CRHF)

Draw Location: Chinook Regional Hospital, 960 – 19 St S, Lethbridge, AB

Draw Type: Electronic 50/50 (RNG – Random Number Generator through Ascend)

Draw Frequency: Every second Wednesday from April 8, 2026 to March 24, 2027

Ticket Sales: Via Ascend Fundraising Solutions electronic platform (chinook5050.ca)

1. Eligibility

1. Entry is open to all Alberta Health Services (AHS) staff, volunteers, and members of the public.
2. Prohibited person(s): The following individuals, and any immediate family members residing in the same household, are not eligible to purchase tickets or win prizes:
 - a. Raffle administrators
 - b. CRH Foundation staff and Board of Directors
 - c. Members, partners, or employees of any licensed gaming suppliers providing services to the Chinook 50/50 Lottery
 - d. Anyone under the age of 18
3. All purchasers must be:
 - a. At least 18 years of age, and
 - b. Physically located within the Province of Alberta at the time of purchase.

2. Ticket Information

1. Ticket price:
 - 1 for \$5 = 80,000 tickets
 - 4 for \$15 = 76,000 tickets
 - 8 for \$25 = 64,000 tickets
 - 20 for \$50 = 40,000 tickets
2. Ticket purchases are available both online through the Foundation website and in-person at the Foundation office.
3. Ticket limits: A total of 260,000 tickets will be printed and/or made available through the electronic raffle system.
4. All ticket sales are final; no refunds will be issued after the commencement of a draw.
5. Ticket purchases are not tax deductible, and prizes are tax-exempt.
6. Ticket purchasers must ensure all contact information provided is accurate and complete; CRHF is not responsible for misdirected communication due to incomplete information.
7. If a ticket stub lists more than one individual, only the first name listed will be considered the official ticket holder and prize claimant. The Foundation and AGLC are not responsible for disputes between individuals whose names appear on a single ticket.

3. Draw Process

1. Each draw will be conducted at 10:00 a.m. every second Wednesday at the CRH Foundation office (960 9th Street South) using a certified Random Number Generator (RNG) provided by Ascend Fundraising Solutions.
2. If a scheduled draw date falls on a statutory holiday or during an unexpected interruption (e.g., power failure, system outage), the draw will occur on the next business day.
3. Ticket sales close at 9:00 a.m. on draw day and will reopen for the next draw immediately after.
4. A minimum of 10 tickets must be sold during a draw period for the raffle to proceed. If this minimum is not met, the Foundation may request a draw-date extension or cancellation approval from AGLC.
5. All draws will be recorded and verified by a designated CRHF raffle administrator and one independent witness.
6. If it is determined prior to the draw that a ticket has been issued to a minor, the ticket will be deemed void, and the purchaser will be refunded in full amount.
7. The draw event will be open to the public and supervised by an approved CRHF representative.

4. Prize Details

1. This is a 50/50 lottery; the winner receives 50% of gross ticket sales for that draw period.
2. Prizes are paid either by cheque or e-transfer funds to the verified winner. Payout for both cheque and e-transfer may take up to six weeks of the draw date.
3. If a winner cannot be reached or fails to claim their prize within 3 months of the draw date, the unclaimed prize will be reported to AGLC, and the Foundation will request approval for the prize amount to revert to the Foundation's approved Use of Proceeds.
4. Unclaimed prizes will not be re-drawn.

5. Winner Notification & Verification

1. The winning ticket number and winner's first name and last name initial will be posted on www.chinook5050.ca, circulated via email to AHS South Zone employees, and announced internally at Chinook Regional Hospital.
2. The winner will be contacted by phone and/or email by the CRHF office.
3. To claim a prize, the winner must present a valid government photo ID and confirm name, address, and contact details either in person at CRHF office or by emailing 5050@crhfoundation.ca.
4. If identification cannot be immediately provided, winning proceeds will be held until a valid photo ID is received.
5. Prizes may be picked up in person, e-transfer, or mailed to the verified winner.

6. Privacy & Publicity

1. The winner acknowledges and grants permission to the Chinook Regional Hospital Foundation to use their first name, initial of last name, city/town of residence, photograph, video, and/or statements for publicity purposes, in any media format, without additional notice, approval, or compensation.
2. Personal information collected is used solely for the administration of this raffle and for communications about future CRHF lotteries and potential partnered lotteries.
3. The Foundation does not rent, sell, or trade donor or participant information.
4. The raffle is administered in accordance with Alberta's Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP) and CRHF's Privacy Policy.
