Ticket Sales: Via Ascend Fundraising Solutions electronic platform (chinooktrucklottery.ca)

1. Eligibility

1. Entry is open to all Alberta Health Services, Alberta Precision Labs, Acute Care Alberta, Assisted Living Alberta, Health Shared Services, Primary Care Alberta, Recovery Alberta and other Provincial Health Agencies (PHA) or Provincial Health Corporations (PHC) as developed by the Government of Alberta, volunteers, and members of the public.
2. Prohibited person(s): The following individuals, and any immediate family members residing in the same household, are not eligible to purchase tickets or win prizes:
 - a. Raffle administrators
 - b. CRH Foundation staff and Board of Directors
 - c. Members, partners, or employees of any licensed gaming suppliers providing services to the Chinook Truck Lottery
 - d. Anyone under the age of 18
3. All purchasers must be:
 - a. At least 18 years of age, and
 - b. Physically located within the Province of Alberta at the time of purchase.

2. Ticket Information

1. Ticket sales commence on May 19, 2026 at 10:00am.
2. Ticket price:
 - 1 for \$25, 4000 tickets available
 - 3 for \$50, 9000 tickets available
 - 10 for \$100, 12,000 tickets available
3. Ticket purchases are available both online through the Foundation website and in-person at the Foundation office and offsite locations.
4. Ticket limits: A total of 25,000 tickets will be printed and/or made available through the electronic raffle system.
5. If 2,000 tickets are not sold by July 1, 2026, the raffle may be cancelled with AGLC approval.
6. All ticket sales are final; no refunds will be issued after the commencement of draws.
7. Ticket purchases are not tax deductible, and prizes are tax-exempt.

8. Ticket purchasers must ensure all contact information provided is accurate and complete; CRHF is not responsible for misdirected communication due to incomplete information.
9. If a ticket stub lists more than one individual, only the first name listed will be considered the official ticket holder and prize claimant. The Foundation and AGLC are not responsible for disputes between individuals whose names appear on a single ticket.

3. Draw Process

1. Each draw will be conducted at 10:00 am on specified draw dates at the CRH Foundation office (960 9th Street South Lethbridge AB T1J 1W5) using a certified Random Number Generator (RNG) provided by Ascend Fundraising Solutions.
2. If a scheduled draw date falls on a statutory holiday or during an unexpected interruption (e.g., power failure, system outage), the draw will occur on the next business day.
3. Ticket sales close at 9:59 am on draw day and will reopen for ticket sales after draw is completed.
4. A minimum of 10 tickets must be sold during a draw period for the raffle to proceed. If this minimum is not met, the Foundation may request a draw-date extension or cancellation approval from AGLC.
5. All draws will be recorded and verified by a designated CRHF raffle administrator and one independent witness.
6. If it is determined prior to the draw that a ticket has been issued to a minor, the ticket will be deemed void, and the purchaser will be refunded full amount.
7. The draw event will be open to the public and supervised by an approved CRHF representative.

Prize: Flights for 2 to any WestJet destination (some restrictions apply, valid for 1 year, cannot be exchanged for cash, flights must be round trip to and from same location, all guests must travel together)

Value: \$2,500

Grand Prize: September 03, 2026

Prize: 2026 Sonic Red Toyota Tundra 4X4 Crew Cab
Value: \$80,374.35

1. No cash alternatives will be offered in lieu of any Early Bird Prizes or Grand Prize truck.
2. All prizes will be in new condition.
3. If a winner cannot be reached or fails to claim their prize within 3 months of the draw date, the unclaimed prize will be reported to AGLC, and the Foundation will request approval for the prize amount to revert to the Foundation's approved Use of Proceeds.
4. Unclaimed prizes will not be re-drawn.

5. Winner Notification & Verification

1. The winning ticket number and winner's first name and last name initial will be posted on www.chinooktrucklottery.ca, circulated via email to South Zone employees, and announced both internally (posted at Foundation office) and externally (social media, email lists, website).
2. The winner will be contacted by phone and/or email by the CRHF office.
3. To claim a prize, the winner must present a valid government photo ID and confirm name, address, and contact details either in person at CRHF office or by emailing info@crhfoundation.ca.
4. If identification cannot be immediately provided, winning prizes will be held until a valid photo ID is received.
5. Early Bird and Grand prizes must be picked up in person by verified winners. The Foundation is not responsible for the delivery of prizes.

6. Privacy & Publicity

1. The winner acknowledges and grants permission to the Chinook Regional Hospital Foundation to use their first name, initial of last name, city/town of residence, photograph, video, and/or statements for publicity purposes, in any media format, without additional notice, approval, or compensation.
2. Personal information collected is used solely for the administration of this raffle and for communications about future CRHF lotteries and potential partnered lotteries.
3. The Foundation does not rent, sell, or trade donor or participant information.
4. The raffle is administered in accordance with Alberta's Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIP) and CRHF's Privacy Policy.
